

SINDH ORDINANCE NO. XIII OF 2001

THE SEHWAN DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 2001

[6TH April 2001]

An Ordinance to amend the Sehwan Development Authority Act, 1994.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sehwan Development Authority Act, 1994, in the manner hereinafter appearing; **Preamble.**

AND WHEREAS the provincial Assembly stands suspended in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fourteenth day of October, 1999, and the Provincial Constitution Order No. 1 of 1999.

AND WHEREAS the Governor of Sindh is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action.

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the aforesaid Proclamation and the Provisional Constitution Order read with Provisional Constitution (Amendment) Order No. 9 of 1999, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Governor of Sindh is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sehwan Development Authority (Amendment) Ordinance, 2001. **Short title, and commencement.**

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sehwan Development Authority Act, 1994, in section 4-

(i) in sub-section (1), for clause (a), the following shall be substituted:-

“(a), The Chairman to be appointed by Government.”.

(ii) after sub-section (1), the following new sub-section shall be inserted:-

“(1-A), The Chairman shall hold office for a period of three years unless he resigns, or is removed earlier from his office.”.
