

**SIND ORDINANCE VIII OF 1974**  
**THE SIND BOARDS OF INTERMEDIATE AND SECONDARY EDUCATION**  
**(AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1974**

[2<sup>nd</sup> May, 1974]

**An Ordinance** to further amend the Sind Boards of Intermediate and Secondary Education Ordinance, 1972.

**WHEREAS** it is expedient to further amend the Sind Boards of Intermediate and Secondary Education Ordinance, 1972, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

**Preamble.**

**AND WHEREAS** the Provincial Assembly is not in session and the Governor of Sind is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 128 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance :-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sind Boards of Intermediate and Secondary Education (Amendment) Ordinance, 1974.

**Short title and commencement.**

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sind Boards of Intermediate and Secondary Education Ordinance, 1972 (hereinafter called the said Ordinance), in sub-section (1) of section 4—

**Amendment of section 4 of Sind Ordinance VI of 1972.**

a) the full stop appearing at the end of clause (ix) shall be replaced by a semi-colon and the word “and”; and

b) the following new clause shall be added:--

“(x) Chairmen of all other Boards.”.

3. In the said Ordinance, for sub-section (2) of section 8, the following shall be substituted:--

**Amendment of section 8 of Sind Ordinance VI of 1972.**

“(2) The quorum of meetings of a Board shall be fifty percent of the total number of members, a fraction being counted as one.”.
