

**SIND ORDINANCE NO.XVIII OF 1974**  
**THE SIND PEOPLE'S LOCAL GOVERNMENT (SECOND AMENDMENT)**  
**ORDINANCE, 1974**

[28<sup>th</sup> December, 1974]

**An Ordinance** to further amend the Sind People's Local Government Ordinance, 1974.

**WHEREAS** it is expedient to further amend the Sind People's Local Government Ordinance, 1974, in the manner hereinafter appearing; **Preamble.**

**AND WHEREAS** the Provincial Assembly is not in session and the Governor of Sind is satisfied that circumstances exist which render immediate action necessary;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by clause (1) of Article 128 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan. The Government of Sindh is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance: -

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sind People's Local Government (Second Amendment) Ordinance, 1974. **Short title and commencement.**

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sind People's Local Government Ordinance, 1974, in sub-section (2) of section 4, for clause (b) the following shall be substituted: — **Amendment of section 4 of Sind Ordinance II of 1972.**

“(b) the officers and administrators performing the duties and functions of local councils and Municipal Committees, shall continue to perform such duties and functions until properly constituted councils assume office in accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance; provided that Government may, in place of any such office or administrator, appoint any person to be the administrator of such local council or the Municipal Committee, as the case may be.”.
