

**SINDH ORDINANCE NO.IV OF 2002**

**THE SINDH CIVIL SERVANTS (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 2002**

[22<sup>nd</sup> January, 2002]

An Ordinance to amend the Sindh Civil Servants Act, 1973.

**WHEREAS** it is expedient to amend the Sindh Civil Servants Act, 1973, in the manner hereinafter appearing; **Preamble.**

**AND WHEREAS** The Provincial Assembly stands dissolved in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fourteenth day of October, 1999 and the Provisional Constitution Order No.1 of 1999;

**AND WHEREAS** the Governor of Sindh is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** in pursuance of the aforesaid Proclamation and the Provisional Constitution Order read with Provisional Constitution (Amendment) Order No.9 of 1999, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Governor of Sindh is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sindh Civil Servants (Amendment) Ordinance, 2002.

**Short title and commencement.**

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sindh Civil Servants Act, 1973, after section 9, the following new section shall be inserted:-

**Amendment of section 9 of Sindh Act XIV of 1973.**

“9-A Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act or any other law for the time being in force or any judgment of any court, a civil servant who provenly exhibits the act of gallantry while performing his duties or very exceptional performance beyond the call of duty, may be granted out of turn promotion or award or reward in such manner as may be prescribed.”.
