

SINDH ORDINANCE NO. VII OF 2002

THE SINDH LOCAL GOVERNMENT (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 2002.

[21st February, 2002]

An Ordinance to amend Sindh Local Government ordinance, 2001, in **Preamble.**
the manner hereinafter appearing;

AND WHEREAS the Provincial Assembly stands dissolved in pursuance of the proclamation of the fourteenth day of October, 1999, and the Provisional Constitution Order No. 1 of 1999.

AND WHEREAS the Governor of Sindh is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the aforesaid Proclamation and the Provisional Constitution Order read with Provisional Constitution (amendment) Order No. 9 of 1999, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Governor of Sindh is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sindh Local Government (Amendment) Ordinance, 2002. **Short title and commencement.**

(2) It shall come into force at once and shall be deemed to have taken effect on and from 14th February, 2002.
2. In the Sindh Local Government Ordinance, 2001, after section 181 the following new Section shall be added:- **Addition of section 181 in Sindh Ordinance No. XXVII of 2001.**

"181-A: Internal Recall of Nazims. – Notwithstanding anything contained in sections 24, 63 and 85 an internal recall motion against the Zila Nazim, Taluka, Town Nazim or Union Nazim elected under this Ordinance, shall not be moved before the 31st December, 2002"
