

SINDH ORDINANCE NO. XXV OF 2002
THE SINDH LOCAL GOVERNMENT (FIFTH AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 2002.

[17TH August, 2002]

An Ordinance to further amend Sindh Local Government Ordinance, 2001.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sindh Local Government Ordinance, 2001, in the manner hereinafter appearing; **Preamble.**

AND WHEREAS the Provincial Assembly stands dissolved in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fourteenth day of October, 1999, and the Provincial Constitution Order No. 1 of 1999.

AND WHEREAS the Governor of Sindh is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action.

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the aforesaid Proclamation and the Provisional Constitution Order read with Provisional Constitution (Amendment) Order No. 9 of 1999, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Governor of Sindh is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sindh Local Government (Fifth Amendment) Ordinance, 2002. **Short title, and commencement.**

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sindh Local Government Ordinance, 2001, hereinafter referred to as the said Ordinance, for section 158, the following shall be substituted:- **[Amendment of section 158 of Sindh Ordinance No. XXVII of 2001.](#)**

“158. Bar against Nazims for dual membership etc.- A Zila Nazim, Naib Zila Nazim, Taluka Nazim, Naib Taluka Nazim, Town Nazim, Union Nazim and Naib Union Nazim, may contest election for any other political office after resigning from the existing office of Nazim, or, as the case may be, naib nazim;

Provided that a member of Zila Council, Taluka Council, Twon Council or Union council may contest election for any other political office without resigning from the membership of such Council;

Provided further that such member shall not hold more than one office at once time.”
