

SINDH ORDINANCE NO.XLII OF 2002

THE SINDH LOCAL GOVERNMENT (SEVENTH AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 2002

[31<sup>st</sup> October, 2002]

An Ordinance to further amend the Sindh Local Government Ordinance, 2001.

**WHEREAS** it is expedient to further amend the Sindh Local Government Ordinance, 2001, in the manner hereinafter appearing; **Preamble.**

**AND WHEREAS** the Provincial Assembly stands dissolved in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fourteenth day of October, 1999, and the Provisional Constitution Order No.1 of 1999;

**AND WHEREAS** the Governor of Sindh is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** in pursuance of the aforesaid Proclamation and Provisional Constitution Order read with Provisional Constitution (Amendment) Order No.9 of 1999, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Governor of Sindh is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sindh Local Government (Seventh Amendment) Ordinance, 2002. **Short title and commencement.**

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sindh Local Government Ordinance, 2001, in section 156, in sub-section (4), for the words “within sixty days” and in sub-section (5), for the words “within thirty days”, the words and commas “within, as far as practicable, one hundred and twenty days” shall be substituted. **Amendment of Section 156 of Sindh Ordinance XXVII of 2001.**
