

**SINDH ORDINANCE NO.IX OF 2010**  
**THE SINDH PUBLIC PROPERTY (REMOVAL OF ENCROACHMENT) (AMENDMENT)**  
**ORDINANCE, 2010.**

[3<sup>rd</sup> December, 2010]

An Ordinance to amend the Sindh Public Property (Removal of Encroachment) Act, 2010.

**WHEREAS** it is expedient to amend the Sindh Public Property (Removal of Encroachment) Act, 2010, in the manner hereinafter appearing; **Preamble.**

**AND WHEREAS** the Provincial Assembly is not in session and the Governor of Sindh is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 128 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the Governor is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance :-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sindh Public Property (Removal of Encroachment) (Amendment) Ordinance, 2010. **Short title and commencement.**

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sindh Public Property (Removal of Encroachment) Act, 2010- **Amendment in section 2 and 26 of Sindh Act XVIII of 2010.**

(i) in section 2, after clause (o), the following new clause shall be added:-

“(oo) “Special Court” means a Special Court established under section 25;”;

(ii) for section 26, the following shall be substituted:-

“26. A Special Court shall consist of a retired Sessions Judge to be appointed by Government.”.
