NO. L.O(E)LG/65/79.- In exercise of the powers conferred by section 103 of the Sind Local Government Ordinance, 1979, read with section 102-T thereof the Government of Sind are pleased to make the following rules:-

1. (1) These rules may be called the Panchayat (Appeal) Rules, 1981. Short title and commencement.
(2) They shall come into force at once.

2. A person aggrieved by an order of the Panchayat may, Appeal.
within thirty days of the order, file appeal to the Magistrate of a First Class, hereinafter called as appellate court, having jurisdiction in the electoral unit assigned to the Panchayat.

3. Every appeal shall be made in the form of a petition in writing presented by the appellant or his Pleader and every such petition shall be accompanied by a copy of the order appealed against: Form of appeal.

Provided that if the appellant is in jail, he may present his petition of appeal and the copies accompanying the same to the officer in charge of the jail, who shall thereupon forward such petition and the copies to the appellate court.

4. On receiving the petition of appeal, the appellate court shall, as far as may be, follow the procedure contained in section 421, 422 and 423 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for disposal of the appeal. Procedure for disposal of appeal.
