

SIND ORDINANCE NO.IV OF 1985.

THE SIND CO-OPERATIVE HOUSING AUTHORITY (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1985.

[24th June, 1985].

An Ordinance to amend the Sind Co-operative Housing Authority Ordinance, 1982.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sind Co-operative Housing Authority Ordinance, 1982, in the manner hereinafter appearing; **Preamble.**

AND WHEREAS The Provincial Assembly is not in session and the Governor of Sind is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 128 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance :-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sind Co-operative Housing Authority (Amendment) Ordinance, 1985.

Short title and commencement.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sind Co-operative Housing Authority Ordinance, 1982, hereinafter referred to as the said Ordinance, section 14—

Amendment of section 14 of Sind Ordinance V of 1982.

(i) in sub-section (1), for the words "six months", the words "one year" shall be substituted;

(ii) in sub-section (2), for the words "one year", the words "two years" shall be substituted.

3. In the said Ordinance, after section 14, the following section 14-A shall be inserted:-

Insertion of section 14-A in Sind Ordinance V of 1982.

"14-A. No person, who has been removed from or is otherwise disqualified to hold any office of the society under the Sind Co-operative Societies Act, 1925 or the rules thereunder or the bye-laws of the society shall be eligible to contest the election under sub-section (1) of section 14, unless a period of two years or such

less period as Government may specify in any case, has elapsed since his removal or disqualification, as the case may be.".
