

SIND ORDINANCE NO. IX of 1987.

THE SIND LOCAL GOVERNMENT (FIFTH AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1987.

[28th November, 1987]

An Ordinance to amend the Sind Local Government Ordinance, 1979.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sind Local Government Ordinance in the manner hereinafter appearing;

Preamble.

AND WHEREAS the Provincial Assembly is not in session and the Governor of Sind is satisfied that circumstances exist, which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 128 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sind Local Government (Fifth Amendment) Ordinance, 1987.

Short title and commencement.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sind Local Government Ordinance, 1979, in section 16, in sub-section (2), the full-stop at the end shall be replaced by a colon and thereafter the following proviso shall be added:-

Amendment of section 16 of Sind Ordinance XII of 1979.

“Provided that Government may at any time on the expiry of the term dissolve the council and on such dissolution the functions of the council shall be performed by such person or authority as Government may appoint in this behalf.”.
