An Act to provide for appointments, powers, functions, salaries, allowances and privileges of Advisors to the Chief Minister of Sindh.

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for appointments, powers, **Preamble.** functions, salaries, allowances and privileges of Advisors to the Chief Minister of Sindh;

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

1. (1) This Act may be called the Sindh Advisors (Appointment, Short title and Powers, Functions, Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 2003. Commence-

(2) It shall come into force at once and be deemed to have taken effect on and from 1^{st} January, 2003.

2. In this Act, unless the subject or context otherwise requires, the **Definitions.** following expressions shall have the meanings hereby assigned to them respectively:

- (a) "Advisor" means a person appointed as an Advisor to the Chief Minister under this Act;
- (b) "Chief Minister" means the Chief Minister of Sindh;
- (c) "Family" means the wife, children and parents residing with and wholly dependent upon the Advisor;
- (d) 1* * * * * * * *
- (e) "Government" means the Government of Sindh;
- (f) "prescribed" means prescribed by rules framed under this Act.

3. The provisions of this Act shall have effect notwithstanding anything **Overriding** to the contrary contained in any other law or nay judgment order or decree of any Court.

4. (1) The Chief Minister may, in his discretion from time to time **Appointment** $^{2*} * *$ appoint such number of persons as he considers necessary, to be **and term of** Advisors who shall hold office during the pleasure of the Chief Minister ³[:] **office.**

Provided that an Advisor appointed on or after 1st January, 2003 shall

be deemed to have been appointed under this Act.

(2) An Advisor shall exercise such powers as may be delegated and perform such functions as may be assigned to him by the Chief Minister.

5. An Advisor shall be entitled to such salary, allowances and other privileges as may be determined by Government from time to time.	Salaries, Allowances and Privileges.
6. Save as provided under this Act, no order made or proceedings taken under this Act, or the rules made thereunder by Government or an Advisor shall be called in question in any Court and no injunction shall be granted by any Court in respect of any decision made or proceedings taken in pursuance of any power conferred by, or under this Act, or the rules made thereunder.	Jurisdiction barred.
7. Government may, by notification in the official Gazette, make rules for carrying out the purpose of this Act.	Power to make rules.
