

**SINDH ORDINANCE NO. IX OF 2005**

**THE SINDH TRANSFUSION OF SAFE BLOOD (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 2005.**

[6<sup>th</sup> September, 2005]

**An Ordinance** to amend the Sindh Transfusion of Safe Blood Act, 1996.

**WHEREAS** it is expedient to amend the Sindh Transfusion of Safe Blood Act, 1996, in the manner hereinafter appearing; **Preamble.**

**AND WHEREAS** the Provincial Assembly is not in session and the Governor of Sindh is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 128 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the Governor of Sindh is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sindh Transfusion of Safe Blood (Amendment) Ordinance, 2005. **Short title, and commencement.**

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sindh Transfusion of Safe Blood Act, 1996, hereinafter referred to as the said Act, in section 5, in sub-section (1), for clause (i) the following shall be substituted:- [Amendment of Section 5 of Sindh Act, No. I of 1997.](#)

“(i) Secretary to Government of Sindh,  
Health Department..... Chairman;”.

3. In the said Act, in section 6, after clause (f), the following new clause shall be inserted:- [Amendment of section 6 of Sindh Act No. I of 1997.](#)

“(ff) to seal any premises being used illegally for transfusion of blood or its products or any blood bank which is not working in accordance with the provisions of this Act;”.

4. In the said Act, in section 9, for the words “two years”, the words “three years” shall be substituted. [Amendment of section 9 of Sindh Act No. I of 1997.](#)
