

## SIND ORDINANCE NO. II of 1992

### THE SINDH LOCAL GOVERNMENT (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1992.

[18<sup>th</sup> April, 1992]

An Ordinance to amend the Sindh Local Government Ordinance, 1979.

**WHEREAS** it is expedient to amend the Sindh Local Government Ordinance, 1979, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

**Preamble.**

**AND WHEREAS** the Provincial Assembly is not in session and the Governor of Sindh is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 128 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the Governor of Sindh is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sindh Local Government (Amendment) Ordinance, 1992.

**Short title and commencement.**

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sindh Local Government Ordinance, 1979, in section 58, for sub-section (1-A), the following shall be substituted:--

**Amendment of section 58 of Sind Act XII of 1979.**

“(1—A) Government may, by notification in the Official Gazette, extend the period under sub-section (1), from time to time, for a period not exceeding six months at a time but the total period of such extensions shall not exceed two years.”.

3. Where a Council is not reconstituted on the expiry of the period of its supersession, the period of supersession of such Council shall, notwithstanding anything contained in the Sindh Local Government Ordinance, 1979, be deemed to have been extended upto the date of the coming into force of the Sindh Local Government (Amendment) Ordinance, 1992.

**Period of supersession of certain Councils.**
