

**SINDH ORDINANCE NO. XII of 1994.**

**THE SINDH CIVIL COURTS (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1994.**

[2<sup>nd</sup> June, 1994]

to further amend the Sind Civil Courts Ordinance, 1962.

**WHEREAS** it is expedient to amend the Sind Civil Courts Ordinance, 1962, in the manner hereinafter appearing; **Preamble.**

**AND WHEREAS** the Provincial Assembly of Sindh is not in session and the Governor of Sind is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 128 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sindh Civil Courts (Amendment) Ordinance, 1994.

**Short title and commencement.**

(2) It shall come into force on and from 1<sup>st</sup> April, 1994.

2. In the Sind Civil Courts Ordinance, 1962, in section 18, subsection (1), in clause (a), for the words "two lacs and fifty thousand", the words "five hundred thousand" shall be substituted.
