

**SINDH ORDINANCE NO. XV of 1994.**

**THE SINDH LOCAL GOVERNMENT (SECOND AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1994.**

[11<sup>th</sup> July, 1994]

to amend the Sind Local Government Ordinance, 1979.

**WHEREAS** it is expedient to amend the Sind Local Government Ordinance, 1979, in the manner hereinafter appearing; **Preamble.**

**AND WHEREAS** the Provincial Assembly is not in session and the Governor of Sindh is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 128 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sindh Local Government (Second Amendment) Ordinance, 1994. **Short title and commencement.**  
(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sind Local Government Ordinance, 1979, in section 16, after sub-section (2), the following sub-sections shall be added:— **Amendment of Section 16 of Sind Ordinance No. XII of 1979.**

“(3) Where any person or authority is appointed under sub-section (2), Government may appoint an Advisory Council consisting of such number of persons as it thinks fit to perform such functions as Government may by notification assign to it.

(4) The Advisory Council shall meet as often and in such manner as such person or authority deems fit.

(5) A member of the Advisory Council shall hold office at the pleasure of Government but may at any time resign from membership by addressing letter to Government.

(6) The person or authority appointed under the Proviso to sub-section (2) shall appoint a member of the Advisory Council, or where no such Council is appointed such person or authority may appoint any other person, to exercise the powers and perform the functions of the Chairman of a Panchayat.”.
