

SIND ORDINANCE NO. X of 1987.

THE SIND LOCAL GOVERNMENT (SIXTH AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1987.

[31st December, 1987]

An Ordinance to amend the Sind Local Government Ordinance, 1979.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sind Local Government Ordinance, 1979, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

Preamble.

AND WHEREAS the Provincial Assembly is not in session and the Governor of Sind is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 128 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sind Local Government (Sixth Amendment) Ordinance, 1987.

Short title and commencement.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sind Local Government Ordinance, 1979, in section 20, for sub-section (1) the following shall be substituted:--

Amendment of section 20 of Sind Ordinance XII of 1979.

“(1) No person shall at the same time be a member of more than one council or more than one electoral unit of the same council, but nothing herein contained shall apply to a member of a Zonal municipal Committee on his becoming a member of the Karachi Metropolitan Corporation.”.
