AN ACT to amend the Provincial Motor Vehicles Ordinance, 1965.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Provincial Motor Vehicles Ordinance, 1965, in the manner hereinafter appearing; **Preamble.**

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

1. (1) This Act may be called the Provincial Motor Vehicles (Amendment) Act, 2023. **Short title and commencement.**

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Provincial Motor Vehicles Ordinance, 1965, hereinafter referred to as the said Ordinance, in section 2 – **Amendment of section 2 of the West Pakistan Ordinance No.XIX of 1965.**

(i) for sub-section (9), the following shall be substituted:-

“(9) “fares” includes sums payable for a season ticket or in respect of the hire of a contract carriage, or includes a sums collected from a passenger travelling by any mode of mass transit vehicle through mandatory ticketing system, e-ticketing system, auto fare collection (AFC) system or any fare collection mechanism, as the case may be;”;

(ii) in sub-section (23), after the words “propelled vehicle”, the words “BRT” shall be inserted.

(iii) after sub-section (45), the following new sub-sections shall be added:-

“(46) “service contract” means a contract between the Provincial Transport Authority or any other relevant authority, as may be applicable, and a service provider;

“(47) “service provider” means a service provider engaged pursuant to a service on contract to provide services in respect of the bus rapid transit system and may include, without limitation, the BRTs vehicle operators automatic fare collection provider and operator, station manager, security personal, janitorial and housekeeping service provider.” .

3. In the said Ordinance, in section 45, after sub-section (1), the following new sub-section shall be inserted:-
- Amendment of section 45 of West Pakistan Ordinance No.XIX of 1965.**
- “(II-A). Government may, by notification, in the official gazette and in consultation with the Sindh Mass Transit Authority, fix the maximum or minimum fare or freight for BRT:
- Provided that the children under three feet or not exceeding five years shall be exempted from the fare to travel in BRT vehicle.”.
4. In the said Ordinance, after section 116-A, the following shall be inserted:-
- Insertion of section 116-B in West Pakistan Ordinance No.XIX of 1965.**
- “116-B. **Fines on Bus Rapid Transit System.** (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in the Ordinance or any other law, for the time being in force, if a person commits an offence mentioned in Part B of the Twelfth Schedule, any person, including a Service Provider, authorized by the relevant Provincial Transport Authority or any other relevant authority, as may be applicable, may, at the spot, draw a charge against him stating the offence.
- (2) If a person commits an offence under sub section (1), then the authorized person, including a Service Provider, authorized by the relevant Provincial Transport Authority or any other relevant authority, as may be applicable, may levy, impose and collect the fines and upon collection deposit such sums as may be prescribed.
- (3) If the person failed to pay or deposit the fine at the spot or in the prescribed manner, then the authorized person duly **authorized** by the relevant Provincial Transport Authority or any other relevant authority, as may be applicable, shall file a complaint against the accused before the court of competent jurisdiction.”.
5. In the said Ordinance, after section 121, the following new section shall be inserted:-
- Insertion of new section 121-A in West Pakistan Ordinance No.XIX of 1965.**
- “121-A. **Amendment of Schedules.** Government may, by notification in the official gazette, amend or modify any of the Schedule to this Act.”.
6. In the said Ordinance, for existing Twelfth Schedule-Part-I (Moving Violations), the following shall be substituted:-
- Amendment of Twelfth Schedule of West Pakistan Ordinance No.XIX of 1965.**
